Enforcement Investigation and Analysis Officer Course Conducted in May

Forty U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) employees from across the country spent four weeks in College Station, Texas,

May 3 - 28 to learn about the Enforcement Investigation and Analysis Officer (EIAO) methodology and gain a thorough understanding of the scientific and technical issues related to food safety along with regulatory and enforcement requirements.

The next EIAO course is scheduled for August 9 - September 3. This educational program is conducted through a grant received by the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station in conjunction with the International HACCP Alliance and the Department of Animal Science at Texas A&M University.
